- 18 years or older (Veterans and non-Veterans)
- Have been diagnosed with either
 - Post-traumatic epilepsy (PTE)
 - Traumatic brain injury (TBI)
- Willing and able to undergo a magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) scan

WHAT TO EXPECT

The study will require participants to visit the Beckman Institute on the University of Illinois campus. The visit is expected to take about two hours and will include health questionnaires (about one half hour) and a MRI scan (one hour). Participants will be financially compensated at \$15 per hour for time and travel.
